

Dog First Aid Kit

1. Emergency phone numbers (Veterinarian, Pet Emergency Room, Animal Poison Control, etc.)
2. Current copy of dog's rabies certificate
3. Current clear photo of the dog (in case he goes missing)
4. Kennel lead (loop at end instead of snap, to be used without a collar)
5. Gauze (4 x 4 squares, 2-inch roll)
6. Adhesive bandage tape
7. Thermometer
8. Hydrogen peroxide (to induce vomiting if advised)
9. Ice pack
10. Glucose paste (or a tube of plain white unflavored icing)
11. Bandage Scissors
12. Disposable safety razors
13. Sterile saline eye wash
14. Diphenhydramine (Benadryl)
15. Antibiotic ointment
16. Plastic card (i.e. credit card material) to scrape away stingers
17. Small hand towels
18. Latex or hypoallergenic material gloves
19. Emergency blanket (thin silver material, to prevent chilling, found in camping stores)
20. Tweezers
21. Needle nose pliers (good for removing quills)
22. 6cc oral syringe (to flush wounds)
23. Q-tips (in a sealed package or zip top bag)
24. Styptic powder or pencil
25. Vaseline
26. Vet Wrap (also called coflex)
27. Gallon sized bags (to make a waterproof leg/tail covering)
28. Sanitary pads for human women (use for bandages, very adsorbent, or for padding on splints)
29. Wooden paint sticks (for splints)
30. Brightly colored duct tape (to attach pads to paint stick for padding, to cover vet wrap, etc)
31. Muzzle that fits your dog (when in pain they sometimes snap at people trying to help)
32. Tool box / other container to hold all these items together and for ease of transport.
